The rescheduled July 20 budget session will feature a presentation of the 2025 budget, with a special focus on the priorities that will have the most impact next year. The 2025 budget was approved by the Board of Overseers in its July 14 monthly meeting. It will be voted on by village residents at the NVC Annual Meeting on August 13. The proposed budget with a narrative explaining 2025 changes in comparison to the 2024 budget, graphs showing revenue and operating reserve trends, and a millage calculator is available at https://www.nvcmaine.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/07/NVC_General_Budget_Handout_072024.pdf . The public is encouraged to attend. Brief presentations are followed by open dialog, questions, and input from Village residents. Coffee and donuts (or, in most cases, donut holes) are provided. July 21-28 (Sun-Sun)	Atlantic Challenge International Contest of Seamanship (Belfast) Every two years, a dozen nations convene for a friendly competition and cross cultural gathering where crews showcase their seamanship skills in a series of rowing, sailing, docking, knot tying and navigation events, and build friendly ties with the international crews. Contestants are young adults: all crew members must be over 15; at least half will be under 22. The Contest events take place in Bantry Bay gigs, which are copies of 18th-century French Navy Captain's gigs. These vessels are 38 feet long and are powered by three sails and ten oars. Each nation has their own vessel for the contest. More than 80 gigs have been built by 16 nations for participation in Atlantic Challenge. Typically 12 nations compete.
