Blending Quebec, Balfolk, and New England traditions, the Montreal duo **Roy-James** playing guitar, singing, and cello presents a diverse traditional repertoire, brought together by the finesse of their playing and the sensitivity of their arrangements. The duo comes together with call-and-response songs, melancholic ballads, and fiddle tunes from Quebec and abroad in a vibrant concert.

Singer and guitarist **François-Félix Roy** reinterprets the traditional Quebec repertoire with intimate arrangements that highlight the richness of the melodies and lyrics. His debut solo album, *Peines perdues* (2023) has taken him to various renowned venues in North America and Europe, including the National Theater of Genoa in Italy.

McKinley James is a cellist living in Montreal. She has played with many different symphony orchestras and is a founding member of the award winning band Night Tree. She has toured internationally with classical and traditional music, including to Europe several times and China. McKinley teaches and plays at workshops and festivals around North America including at Fiddle Hell, Maine Fiddle Camp, and Pinewoods. She is also a part of the balfolk trio Malvenn bringing a new dimension to traditional European dance music.
