1921

President's Report

The annexed statement shows the disbursements for the year 1921. During the current year the permanent iron pipe sewer outlet has been installed at a cost of approximately \$1250.00. The washouts caused by the heavy rains of the early summer have made necessary considerable extraordinary expenditure. Nevertheless, it is expected that all payments can be made out of 1922 taxes.

It is a matter of much difficulty for the village officers to decide for what purposes to expend the annual revenues. Many permanent improvements are advisable, but their installation is necessarily limited by the small amount of yearly income in excess of current expenses. For several years past all surplus funds have been used for sewer construction. After another branch line is built, further extension can be held in abeyance until other public improvements are completed.

I advise that the voters authorize a Village Corporation tax levy for the year 1923 in the amount of \$500.00.

I again call attention to the small attendance of voters at the annual meetings.
