No fire pit or open fires are allowed within  
75 feet of any dwelling or structure, or  
within 25 feet of any combustible materials.

All dogs should be on a leash.

Clean up after your pet, it is the law

Vehicles blocking emergency access will be  
towed. No overnight camping or campers  
are allowed.

Bicycles are not to be ridden in parks  
or between cottages.

No skateboards or scooters after dark.

The basketball court shall be vacated by  
9PM, all parks shall be quiet by 10PM, and  
the wharf vacated by 11 PM.

The lifeguard has authority over all  
activities on the wharf and the two floats.



**The Bayside library** is located at the corner of George Street and Clinton Street. It is open most days from 10AM to 5 PM (more or less) and is operated on the honor system. Staffed by volunteers, it features books for every age, and a volunteer based children's reading program. Donations of appropriate books (especially children's books) are welcomed.



**The Northport Yacht Club** is located at the bottom of Ruggles Park near the wharf causeway. Our Sailing Program teaches sailing and safe boating to over 100 children ages 9 to 18 every summer; Lessons are Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings 9:30 till noon at the clubhouse. We are an open, social club and inexpensive to join. We sponsor a wide variety of social events, such as the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Kids games, waterslide and band concert. On Thursday evenings we hold kids sailing races and a potluck cookout that are open to all. Please come down and bring the kids. 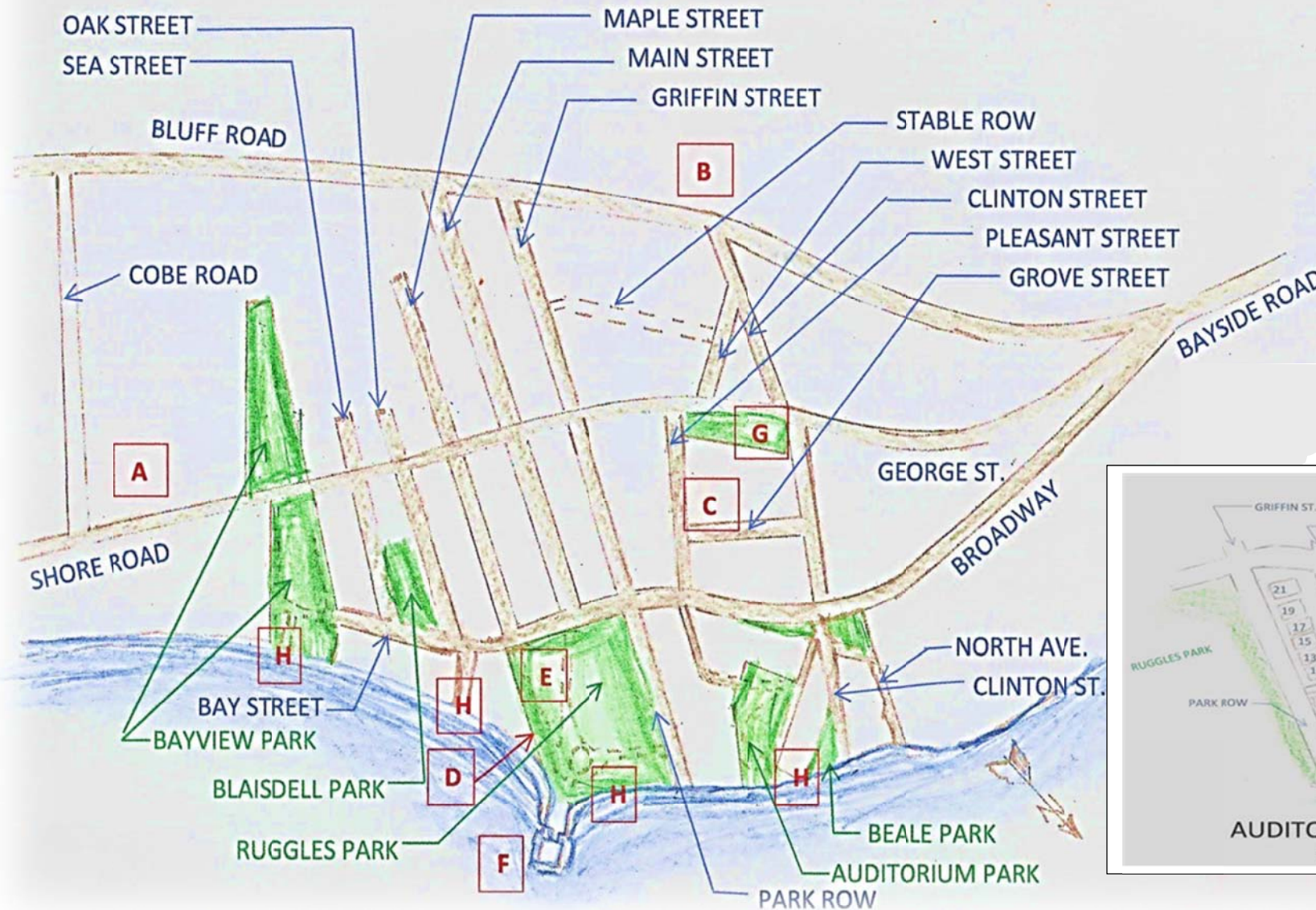

## BAYSIDE POINTS OF INTEREST

**A Community Hall and Village Offices:** Constructed as a silent movie theatre in 1915, the building is now used for public meetings, dances, pot luck suppers and wedding receptions. The basement area contains the Village offices and a meeting room which contains a number of historical displays.

**B Golf Course:** A nine hole golf course and clubhouse open to the public.

**C Museum:** An early Bayside cottage that has been adapted as a museum for the Bayside Historic Preservation Society. In addition to early Bayside articles of interest, the upstairs rooms have been furnished as typical of the early 1900's.

**D Northport Yacht Club:** A modest building with remarkable membership, the NYC sponsors many social events, sailing races, and sailing lessons that are open to everyone.

**E Playground:** Swings, slides, merry-go-round and a basketball court are available for kids of every age.

**F Wharf, boat float, and swim float:** Always the center of activity on any summer day the wharf provides the perfect place for sunbathing, fishing, boating, and life guard supervised swimming.

**G Library:** A free library serving Bayside's needs for readers of all ages, from children to adults.

**H Shore Access:** Although the Village has several points of access to the shore, the most popular location is near the wharf (which is the only available point that has parking).



## PUBLIC WALKWAYS

Public walkways are provided for the convenience of pedestrians, and are limited to foot traffic alone. No running and especially no riding bicycles. Please avoid trespassing on private properties.
